The following letter will include tips and procedures for the upkeep of your new wood finishes.

### **Proper Care**

#### **Removal of Dust:**

Dust is made up of small, airborne particles which can build up and, if not removed correctly, may scratch or dull the surface of the finish. Simple wipe the surface with a cloth dampened with a cleaning polish or mild detergent.

#### **Cleaning:**

Oil from fingerprints, cooking fumes, smoke residue and other contaminants accumulate on any finished surface. None of these contaminants will harm your finish but should be periodically removed to restore the finish to its original luster. Just wipe the surface with a cloth dampened with a polish that doesn't contain wax, or mild detergent solutions. Use of ammonia-based products and silicone oils may cause damage if used over a long period. Clean only as often as needed to keep surface contaminants from building up on your wood.

#### **Note:**

This finish is durable, but spills should be cleaned properly. Also excessive exposure to direct sunlight, high temperatures and high humidity can cause damage to the finish and wood itself.
